

INFORMATION SHEET FOR FOOD STALLS - 2010 BUSSELTON BEACH FESTIVAL

(Please read thoroughly and retain for your own records)

The 2010 Tribal Mix / Big Mix markets will be located at the Busselton Main Beachfront on Saturday 16th January & Sunday 17th January.

On Saturday 16th January Cultural activities and the Beach Party/Fireworks at the Main Beachfront will be scheduled from **1.00pm through until 9:30pm.**

A Youth Program will be held on Sunday 17th January, incorporating the Battle of the Young Bands – activities will start in the morning finishing at 9pm.

It is the responsibility of the stallholder to comply with Health Regulations as stipulated by the Shire of Busselton. A representative from the Shire reserves the right to inspect food stalls operating during the Festival.

Restrictions on the number and type of food stalls do apply, so please list all main selling items.

The Artatac Committee would like to inform all stallholders and participants that they are responsible for their own public liability insurance.

Stalls are to be set up between 7:00am – 9:45am. Sites will be allocated by an Artatac representative, located at the Carnival site.

Only vehicles from which goods are to be sold are to be parked within bays.

Trestles, tables, power chords, power boards, etc are NOT supplied. Please make your own arrangements.

Limited power facilities are available. If you require power, please ensure this is noted on your application form and the appropriate fee paid. Stallholders intending to trade on Saturday evenings are responsible for providing their own lighting. No

responsibility will be taken by the Artatac Committee for stallholders who have not correctly advised their power requirements.

Limited shade is available. Please make appropriate arrangements.

Sites/bays are based on a 3 metre frontage x 3 metre depth. Sites requiring a large area will need to pay for more than one bay.

The location of stalls will be determined by the Artatac Committee which reserves the right to change stall locations without notice.

The Artatac Committee reserves the right to refuse stallholders.
